Tour #1 St. Nicholas Abbey

Starts: 9:00 AM Departs from Conference Venue

This charming plantation house was built in 1658 and is one of only three genuine Jacobean mansions in the Western Hemisphere. It is one of the islands' unique heritage tourism attractions located in the north of the island. Delegates will enjoy a tour of the great house, gardens and rum sampling from its distillery. The tour will continue to Speightstown for lunch and along the West Coast for an afternoon of Shopping at the Limegrove Lifestyles Centre.

Tour #2 UNESCO Heritage Tour

Starts 9:00 A.M. Departs from Conference Venue

End: 3:30 P.M.

A tour of the Capital which was recently designated a UNESCO World Heritage Property - Historic Bridgetown and its Garrison. This fun jitney bus ride will take delegates to the Kensington Oval, the Barbados Museum, Queens Park and to the new Blackwood's Screw Dock facility.
