Resolution AG/RES. 2976 (LI-O/21) "Promotion and Protection of Human Rights," which the General Assembly adopted in November 2021, requested the Permanent Council to instruct the Committee on Juridical and Political Affairs (CAJP) to include in its plan of action the following issue covered by this resolution, prior to the fifty-second regular session of the General Assembly with a view to promoting the sharing of experiences and best practices: "Autonomous official public defenders as a guarantee of access to justice for women in vulnerable situations."

Likewise, in paragraph i, the said resolution requested the Permanent Council to hold in the first quarter of 2022, "a tenth special meeting of the CAJP on best practices employed by each official public defense institution in the region for ensuring access to justice for women in vulnerable situations in defense of their human rights, to be attended by the member states and their respective official public defender institutions that provide legal aid, members of the AIDEF, and experts from the academic community, civil society, and international organizations."
