DECLARATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF HONDURAS ON THE INTER-AMERICAN CONVENTION ON MUTUAL ASSISTANCE IN CRIMINAL MATTERS

The Inter-American Convention on Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters was adopted in the meeting chamber of the National Congress of the Republic of Honduras by Legislative Decree No. 81-2006 of August 2, 2006, published in Official Gazette No. 31,099 of September 6, 2006, ratified by our country on September 25, 2006, and its instrument of ratification deposited with that Organization on November 10, 2006.

In that connection the Republic of Honduras makes the following declaration:

"DECLARATION OF THE REPUBLIC OF HONDURAS. The Republic of Honduras makes the following reservation in accordance with Article 35 of the Convention: With respect to the second paragraph of Article 24 'Transmittal of Information and Records,' the State will not make available copies of any document, record, or other information that is not public in nature. In addition, in accordance with Article 3 of the Convention, the Ministry of the Interior and Justice of the Republic of Honduras, now named the Ministry of Human Rights, Justice, the Interior and Decentralization, pursuant to Legislative Decree No. 266-2013, is designated as the Central Authority."
