ANNOUNCEMENT

On **Monday, March 7, 2016**, a **Course on International Refugee Law** will take place at the OAS headquarters (1889 F St. NW, Washington, D.C., Ruben Dario Room, 8th floor), pursuant to a mandate contained in [General Assembly resolution 2839 \(XLIV-O/14\)](#) "Protection of Asylum Seekers and Refugees in the Americas", which instructed the Permanent Council to organize the course **through the Committee on Juridical and Political Affairs and with support from the Department of International Law of the General Secretariat and the technical and financial collaboration of the UNHCR.**

Languages

The course will be held in English and Spanish, with available simultaneous interpretation in all four official languages of the Organization.

Participation

The course is open for staff of the permanent missions of the member states, staff of the General Secretariat of the OAS, as well as for other interested persons.
