U.S. AND INTERNATIONAL ANTI-CORRUPTION LAW PROGRAM

- Four categories of training and education directed at working professionals and law students
 - Academic Year courses
 - Summer Program for practitioners
 - Custom-tailored courses for specific professional groups and topics
 - Academic-year events on corruption-related topics

PROGRAM: ACADEMIC YEAR COURSES

- Juris Doctor Students: U.S. and International Anti-Corruption Law and Financial Crimes Compliance
 - Open to second- and third-year J.D. students and LL.M students
 - Courses include guest lecturers from former federal prosecutors, compliance counsel, and other experts
 - Courses count towards Compliance and Ethics Certificate in WCL Business Law Program
- Master of Legal Studies Students: Anti-Corruption Law (synchronous and asynchronous)

PROGRAM: SUMMER PROGRAM

- Summer Program offers practitioners (legal and non-legal professionals) three intensive courses related to anti-corruption, with Certificates and Continuing Legal Education credit available
 - U.S. and International Anti-Bribery Law and Practice
 - Public Procurement Corruption Risk and Mitigation: World Bank Practice
 - U.S. Anti-Corruption Legal Framework
- Summer Program courses also feature recognized experts in anti-corruption, such as former federal prosecutors, Inspectors General, and private law practitioners
- 2022 Summer Program included a total of 22 in-person and remote professionals from Belize, Colombia, Ecuador, Lebanon, Liberia, Mexico, Philippines, United Kingdom, and United States

PROGRAM: CUSTOM COURSES

- Custom-tailed courses for specific professional groups and topics arranged with WCL faculty
 - Example: Brazilian prosecutors (2019)
 - Courses can be offered with Spanish-speaking lecturers

OTHER ACADEMIC-YEAR EVENTS

- Frank H. Menaker Corporate Integrity Initiative
 - Features annual lecture on corporate integrity (Fall 2022 U.S.
 Department of Justice Deputy Assistant Attorney General Lisa Miller scheduled)
 - Also provides measure of financial support for Summer Program attendees
- Webinars feature experts from government and private sector on timely corruption-related topics
 - E.g., Biden Administration anti-corruption policies
