

CJI/RES. 212 (LXXXVI-O/15)

PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA

THE INTER-AMERICAN JURIDICAL COMMITTEE,

CONSIDERING the mandate agreed at the General Assembly in June 2013 through Resolution AG/RES. 2811 (XLIII-O/13), which commissioned the Inter-American Juridical Council to draft proposals for the Commission for Legal and Political Affairs on the various ways to regulate the protection of personal data, including a Draft Law on Personal Data, taking into account the international standards already established on the matter”;

IN VIEW OF the report presented by the Rapporteur of the theme, Dr. David P. Stewart, on 24 March 2015, “Privacy and protection of personal data”, CJI/doc.474/15 rev.1, which contains legislative guidelines for the Member States comprised of twelve “OAS Principles on protection of privacy and personal data, with notes”,

RESOLVES:

1. To thank the Rapporteur of the theme, Dr. David P. Stewart, for his presentation of the document “Privacy and protection of personal data”, CJI/doc.474/15 rev.1.
2. Approve the report of the Inter-American Juridical Committee, “Privacy and protection of personal data”, [CJI/doc.474/15 rev.2](#), annexed to this resolution.
3. Send this resolution to the Permanent Council of the Organization of the American States.
4. Consider the work of the Inter-American Juridical Committee on this theme concluded.
