Before applying, make sure you have all the documents required in this checklist. Remember that in order for you application to be eligible for the Brazil Scholarship PAEC OAS-GCUB, you must attach each of the following documents (they may be submitted in English, Spanish, Portuguese or French) and follow the process established in the Announcement).

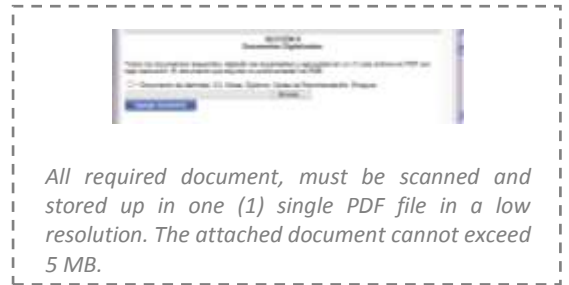

3. In SECTION III **Digital Documents**, please attach the PDF with all the documents listed below:



Digital Documents

Copy of official identification document

Citizenship document, passport, national identification document, etc. issued by your government

Curriculum Vitae (maximum 5 pages)

Do not include supporting documents, i.e. certificates, awards, etc.

Academic Transcripts (Official copy of academic record issued by your university)

Applicants to master's and/or doctorate: all completed courses during undergraduate studies

Diploma*

Applicants to a master's and/or doctorate: diploma of the bachelor's degree (or its equivalent)

If you do not hold the diploma, you may attach a **certificate of completion issued by the university confirming that you have completed all program requirements (including submission and defense of graduation papers/exams, if applicable) and the expected date when the degree will be awarded.*

Two (2) letters of recommendation

Two letters of recommendation, preferably from university professors or other people of renowned academic or work expertise. There is no specific format required.

Essays with the following specifications:

For each of the Master's/Doctorate program that you apply, you must write 3 essays according to the following specifications:



STUDY PROGRAM

Select **up to three (3) study programs** for doctorate or master's degrees t. Each one of those programs must be in different universities located in different regions in Brazil.

**Take in consideration that if you apply to 3 study programs, you must send 9 essays in total.*



ESSAY 1

ACADEMIC EXPECTATIONS & INTERESTS

(maximum of two pages)

Academic expectations and interests, professional expectations and prospects upon return to the country of origin.



ESSAY 2

JUSTIFICATION OF THE PROGRAM SELECTION

(maximum of eight pages)

For each of the Master's or Doctoral programs, present a justification of the program selection, central theme and problem to be investigated, delimitation and justification of the object of study, bibliographic review, methodological procedures, timeline and bibliographic references.



ESSAY 3

FUNDING & START DATE OF THE PROGRAM

(maximum of one page)

Letter of commitment describing each of the following aspects:

- Source(s) of funding and a payment plan for expenses not covered by the scholarship program (i.e. airfare, international medical insurance, additional subsistence expenses, and visa fees).
- Ability to relocate to Brazil before the expected start date of the program and to reside there for the duration of the study program.
