

The DEPM/OAS issues Special Recognitions in the Framework of the Inter-American Award on Innovation for Effective Public Management – 2014 in Peru

The Department for Effective Public Management (DEPM) of the Organization of American States (OAS) issued special recognitions to two (2) Peruvian national entities:

- The Supervisory Body of State Procurement (OSCE) for its innovative experience "Arbitration Record of the OSCE: Transparency that builds trust in management and arbitration system"; finalist in the category Open Government and Access to Public Information, and
- The National Identification and Civil Registry (RENIEC) for its innovative "Children ID and its impact on the enjoyment of human rights and the development of the country"; finalist in the category Quality of Public Policies.
