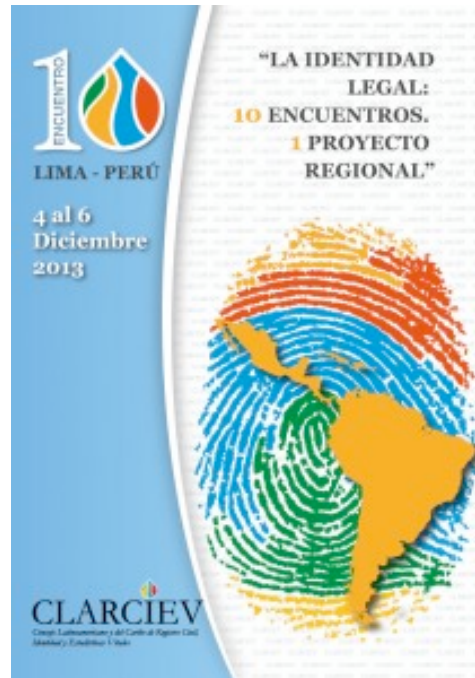

The Latin American and Caribbean Council of Civil Registration, Identity and Vital Statistics took place in Lima, Perú



The Department for Effective Public Management (DEPM) by the Program for Universal Civil Identity in the Americas (PUICA) and National Registry of Identification and Civil Status (RENIEC) of Peru organized this year's X Meeting of the Latin American and Caribbean Council Civil Registration, Identity and Vital Statistics (CLARCIEV) called "The Legal Identity: 10 Games, 1 Regional Project". The event took place from 4 to 6 December in the city of Lima, Peru and included representatives of civil registries in Latin America and the Caribbean.

The meeting as central themes exchanged good practices and technological advances, the interoperability of Vital Records, strengthening CLARCIEV website as a mechanism for regional training and evaluation and advancement of the Legal Personality of CLARCIEV. While recounting the achievements of the last decade, since the beginning of CLARCIEV and discuss the work required to meet the target "under- 0" will be held in 2015.
