THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

THE GENERAL SECRETARIAT OF THE ORGANIZATION OF AMERICAN STATES THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN DEVELOPMENT, EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT

AND

THE UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, JAMAICA

FOR

THE OAS-UTECH SCHOLARSHIP

The Parties, the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States ("GS/OAS"), through its Department of Human Development, Education and Employment ("DHDEE"), and the University of Technology, Jamaica ("UTECH"),

CONSIDERING:

That on August 17, 2016 the Parties signed the Memorandum of Understanding between the GS/OAS through the DHDEE and UTECH for the OAS-UTECH Scholarship ("MOU"), and have since amended the MOU through the First Amendment to the MOU on March 7, 2017, and through the Second Amendment to the MOU on November 11, 2019;

That Article 8.3 of the MOU provides for its amendment by way of a writing signed by the duly authorized representatives of both Parties,

THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE:

1. Article 1.1 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The University Shall hold space for ten (10) qualified selected candidates for the OAS-UTECH Scholarship ("Scholarship Recipients") in its Master of Science in Public Health Nutrition in English ("Program"). The Scholarships will be awarded before the start of classes in the Program each year.

2. Article 1.3 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The Program starts on August 24, 2020 and ends on July 31, 2022.

3. Article 1.5 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

To qualify for the OAS-UTECH Scholarship, applicants must first apply for admission to the Program and the OAS-UTECH Scholarship separately. The deadline to apply for admission to the Program is July 10, 2020 and the application deadline of the OAS-UTECH Scholarship is July 31, 2020.

4. Article 2.1 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The University shall cover USD 2,500 of the total program fees for ten (10) OAS-UTECH Scholarship Recipients for a total of USD 25,000.

5. Article 2.2 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The GS/OAS shall cover USD 3,500 of the total program fees for ten (10) OAS-UTECH Scholarship recipients for a total of USD 35,000, paid directly to the University in one single installment, in accordance with the terms of Article 3.3 of the MOU that are not inconsistent with this Amendment.

6. Article 2.3 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

Neither the University nor GS/OAS shall provide funds to Scholarship Recipients for the following expenses:

- Remaining program of costs USD 6,800 not covered by the OAS-UTECH Scholarship;
- Research expenses; and
- Any additional costs and fees that are not included in the OAS-UTECH Scholarship.
- 7. Article 3.3.1 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

To receive the total payment of USD 35,000, the University shall submit the corresponding invoice to:

8. Article 8.4. of the MOU is hereby amended and replaced with the following:

This MOU may be terminated by written agreement signed by the Parties, or may be terminated unilaterally by either Party without cause upon no less than thirty (30) days' prior written notice to the other; however, if terminated unilaterally, this MOU shall remain in force until December 31, 2023 with respect to all Scholarship Recipients who as of the date the notice is given, have already enrolled in a Program or have been officially notified of their selection as Scholarship Recipients for the academic years covered under this MOU. In the event of unilateral termination, neither the University nor GS/OAS shall be obligated to cover expenses listed under Article 2.3.

9. All terms and conditions of the MOU that are not inconsistent with this Third Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.

10. This Amendment to the MOU shall be attached as an Annex to the MOU and shall be read as one document with the same legal effect.
