After the signing of this letter, GS/OAS will provide to Determan Communications LLC the sum of US\$ 2,000 as a contribution for the services provided.


Determan Communications LLC bears no liability under this agreement, except to the extent it is found to have resulted from the willful misconduct or gross negligence of Determan Communications LLC.




