The Embassy of Japan in the United States of America presents its compliments to the Organization of American States (OAS) and under the instructions of the Government of Japan, has the honor to inform the latter that the Government of Japan has decided to make a contribution of eight million, two hundred and thirty six thousand seventy seven US Dollars (US\$ 8,236,077) (hereinafter referred to as the "Grant") to OAS for the execution of its project listed in the Attachment (hereinafter referred to as the "Project").

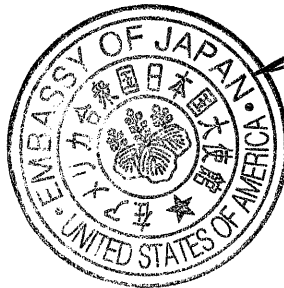
The Embassy of Japan has further the honor to request OAS to ensure the following:

- (1) OAS will notify the Government of Japan in writing of the number and type (and the name and address) of US dollar bank account of OAS in which the Grant to be transferred.
- (2) The Grant will be used immediately, appropriately and exclusively for the execution of the Project.
- (3) Every effort will be made to publicize and increase the visibility of the Japanese contribution through, for example, the issuance of press releases, organizing launching or completion ceremonies, as well as attaching the Japanese national flag, printing "From the People of JAPAN" on OAS's equipment procured with the contribution, and placing signboards identifying the contribution of the Government of Japan in appropriate places.
- (4) A letter to inform the completion of the grant, as well as a detailed report on the use and the effect of the Grant will be submitted to the Embassy of Japan in the country where the Project will take place. A copy of the letter and the report will be submitted to the Embassy of Japan in the United States of America.
- (5) The Government of Japan and OAS will consult with each other in respect of any matter that may arise from or in connection with the Grant.
