The Parties, the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States ("GS/OAS"), through its Department of Human Development, Education and Employment ("DHDEE"), and The New School ("TNS"),

## **CONSIDERING:**

That on September 8, 2022, the Parties signed a Scholarship Agreement between the GS/OAS through the DHDEE and TNS for the OAS-New School PAEC Scholarship ("Scholarship Agreement"); and

That Article 11.3 of the Scholarship Agreement provides for its amendment by way of a writing signed by the duly authorized representatives of both Parties,

# THE PARTIES HEREBY AGREE:

1. Article 2.1 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The New School shall offer graduate program for students selected to receive a PAEC, which shall be referred to as the OAS-New School PAEC Scholarship in promotional materials. The Program(s) of study, its/their duration and other details are set forth below:

2. Article 4.1 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

The University shall offer 50% tuition waiver, that may range between USD \$31,968 to USD \$38,184 depending on the total number of credits required to earn the master's degree, to ten (10) recipients of the OAS-New School PAEC Scholarship for each of the Programs identified in Article 2.1.

3. This First Amendment to the Scholarship Agreement shall be attached as an Annex to the Scholarship Agreement and shall be read as one document with the same legal effect.
