THIRTY-NINTH ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

Pursuant to Article 10.1 of the Memorandum of Understanding between the General Secretariat of the Organization of American States (GS/OAS), through the Executive Secretariat for Integral Development (SEDI), and the Young Americas Business Trust (YABT) concerning the execution of activities under the program "Competitiveness Program" signed on Tuesday August 10, 2010 (hereinafter the MOU) and the subsequent amendments to the MOU, the duly authorized representatives of the Parties under the MOU agree on the following:

AMENDMENTS:

1.1. Upon the signing of these Articles of Amendment, GS/OAS will make available to YABT the amount of USD \$15,000 (hereinafter the "GS/OAS Contribution"), to implement activities under the MOU. This GS/OAS Contribution will be transferred to the account specified by the YABT coordinator as established in the MOU, in accordance with Appendix XXXIX, attached herein.

1.2. The activities and allocation of the GS/OAS Contribution are detailed in Appendix XXXIX to the MOU. The updated budget and activities do not change the nature of the Program pursuant to Article 3.3 of the MOU and are fully authorized in writing by the SEDI Program Manager.



1.4. The Parties agree that the MOU shall remain in force until August 31, 2019, pursuant to Article 10.2 of the MOU.
