NCB Foundation Study grant for OAS Scholarship Recipients of Jamaican Citizenship

OAS scholarship recipients of Jamaican citizenship, who are pursuing undergraduate degrees in computer science, data science or analytics and come from challenged economic backgrounds can apply to the N.C.B. Foundation for additional funding in the amount of US\$5000 per year, based on the following conditions:

- maintaining a minimum GPA of 3.0 or B average
- extending a minimum of eight(8) hours of voluntary service to your (school) community or a reputable entity/charity.
- demonstrating a level of financial need.

Interested OAS scholarship recipients may apply for this grant by submitting their funding request to the NCB Foundation by email to: ncbfoundation@jncb.com with copy to the OAS Office in Jamaica at: oasjamaica@oas.org

The funding request should include:

- Letter of request noting why support is being sought
- Letter of acceptance from the student's University/College
- Provision of most recent transcript
- Proof of community service
- Letter from the OAS confirming the student's status as an OAS scholarship recipient
- Copy of ID (passport, driver's license or national ID)
