



32.7 All persons promoted shall receive the minimum of one increment

32.8 The Employer undertakes to review all existing procedures for promotions in an effort to ensure a system which achieves greater fairness and transparency

ARTICLE 33

POSITION VACANCY NOTICE

33.1 When a vacancy occurs within the Public Service a position vacancy notice will be published internally inviting applications within a period not less than thirty (30) working days from the date of publication. Such notice shall also be copied to the Union. Interested employees shall have the right to apply and be considered, provided their written applications are received within the specified period.

33.2 Such notice will state the required qualifications and experience as well as the salary scale and job classification

33.3 No contract worker will be hired to fill such vacancy unless it is determined by the Employer that existing employees are not capable of filling the vacancy.

ACTING APPOINTMENT

33.4 An acting allowance will be payable only to an officer who is formally appointed to discharge the duties of an Office of Responsibility. The rates of acting allowances (and responsibility allowance) are set out in the Public Service Act.

33.5 An acting allowance will be payable from the date of commencement of his/her acting appointment to the date of its termination.

33.6 An officer appointed to act in another post will be eligible for the allowance attached to the higher office
