ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SERVICE COMMISSIONS

THE SERVICE COMMISSIONS ARE BODIES ESTABLISHED BY THE CONSTITUTION OF T&T

THERE ARE FOUR (4) SERVICE COMMISSIONS:

TO ACHIEVE THESE OBJECTIVES, THE CONSTITUTION BUILT IN SAFEGUARDS:	
APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONERS ARE ALL MADE BY THE PRESIDENT AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE PRIME MINISTER AND THE LEADER OF THE OPPOSITION	

(1) A PERSON IS NOT QUALIFIED WHO:	
(1) AFERSON IS NOT QUALITIED WITO.	
- IS A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OR THE SENATE;	
- HOLDS OR HAS ACTED IN ANY PUBLIC OFFICE OR HAS HELD ANY PUBLIC	
OFFICE WITHIN THE THREE YEARS PRECEDING HIS PROPOSED	
APPOINTMENT	
SIMILARLY IF SOMEONE WAS A COMMISSIONER HE IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR	
APPOINTMENT TO ANY PUBLIC OFFICE WITHIN A PERIOD OF THREE YEARS	
FROM THE DATE HE LAST HELD THE OFFICE OF COMMISSIONER;

(2) A MEMBER OF A SERVICE COMMISSION CAN	
ONLY BE DEMOVED FROM DEFICE BY THE	

PRESIDENT

- FOR INABILITY TO DISCHARGE THE FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE, WHETHER ARISING FROM INFIRMITY OF MIND OR BODY
- MISBEHAVIOUR IN PUBLIC OFFICE,
 IF THEY BECOME DISQUALIFIED FROM
 HOLDING OFFICE BY VIRTUE OF ELECTION TO
 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OR THE
 SENATE.

(3) EACH COMMISSION FUNCTIONS AS A BODY GIVING EFFECT TO THE PRINCIPLE OF JOINT RATHER THAN INDIVIDUAL RESPONSIBILITY; (4) COMMISSIONS ARE FREE FROM MINISTERIAL CONTROL (5) COMMISSIONERS CANNOT BE SUED IN THEIR NAMES BUT ONLY AS A BODY **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF** SERVICE COMMISSIONS TO FILL MANPOWER NEEDS OF MINISTRIES AND DEPARTMENTS IN ORDER TO ENSURE THE EFFICIENT PROVISION OF COLLECTIVE **SERVICES** TO GUARD THE PUBLIC AGAINST HAVING TO DEAL WITH UNFIT EMPLOYEES BY TESTING THE QUALIFICATIONS ACADEMIC OR OTHERWISE OF PERSONS WHO SEEK APPOINTMENT TO ASSURE THE PUBLIC OF PUBLIC SERVICE NEUTRALITY BY ASSERTING THEIR CONSTITUTIONAL AUTHORITY IN RESPECT OF THE CONTROL OF CAREERS IN THE SERVICE

TO PROTECT PUBLIC OFFICERS AGAINST ACTS OF DISCRIMINATION BY POLITICIANS TO PROTECT PUBLIC OFFICERS FROM OTHER PUBLIC OFFICERS TO PROTECT POLITICIANS FROM THE POSSIBILITY OF PRESSURE OF PERSONS DEMANDING PLACES FOR FRIENDS AND FAMILY AS THE PRICE FOR POLITICAL SUPPORT TO ENSURE GOOD CONDUCT AND EFFICIENCY OF PUBLIC OFFICERS BY EXERCISING THEIR CONSTITUTIONAL AUTHORITY IN RESPECT OF DISCIPLINE **LIMITATIONS ON THE POWERS OF THE SERVICE COMMISSIONS**

CAN ONLY FILL APPROVED OFFICES FOR WHICH FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE SALARIES MUST BE WITHIN THE APPROVED **RANGES** APPOINTEES MUST POSSESS THE QUALIFICATIONS PRESCRIBED THERE MUST BE CONSULTATION WITH THE PRIME MINISTER WHEN MAKING CERTAIN APPOINTMENTS (P.S; COP/certain HODs) MUST BE CONSULTATION WITH OTHER SERVICE COMMISSIONS WHERE APPOINTMENTS INVOLVE THE SELECTION OF OFFICERS UNDER ANOTHER COMMISSION'S JURISDICTION; PSC MUST CONSULT THE AUDITOR GENERAL AND THE OMBUDSMAN WHEN MAKING APPOINTMENT TO OR TRANSFERS OF MEMBERS OF STAFF OF THOSE DEPARTMENTS **PROCESSES** IN CONSIDERING MATTERS WITHIN THE PURVIEW OF THEIR CONSTITUTIONAL POWERS, THE COMMISSIONS ARE GUIDED BY THE PRINCIPLE, PROCEDURE, AND RULES SET OUT IN - THEIR REGULATIONS (Public Service Commission Regulations Chapter 1:01/Police Service Commission Regulations)
