IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED BY SECTION 6(1) OF THE EXTRADITION ACT, 1998 (NO. 22 OF 1998) THE MINISTER FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER —

1. Citation: These regulations may be cited as the

EXTRADITION ACT (UNITED STATES OF AMERICA) ORDER 2001.

- 2. Application of Act: General extradition arrangements having been made between Grenada and the United States of America, as contained in the Extradition Treaty between the Government of Grenada and the Government of the United States of America set out in the Schedule to Act No. 2 of 2001, it is directed that from the date of publication of this Order in the Gazette the extradition procedures contained in Part IV of the Extradition Act 1998 (herein called "the Act") apply as between Grenada and the United States of America.
- 3. Limitations on surrender: The surrender of a person pursuant to this Order is subject to -
 - (a) the exceptions and qualifications contained in the Schedule to Act No. 2 of 2001;
 - (b) section 8 of the Extradition Act 1998 (which imposes certain general restrictions);
 - (c) section 6(5) of the Extradition Act 1998 (which requires the court of committal to be satisfied that the evidence in respect of a person would be sufficient to warrant the trial of the person if the extradition offence had taken place within the jurisdiction of the court).
