On October 23, 2002, the Government of Canada tabled draft rules for a Code of Conduct for Parliamentarians as well as a draft bill to establish the Ethics Commissioner as the Parliamentary officer to report to Parliament, to administer the Code of Conduct for Parliamentarians, and to advise the Prime Minister on the Conflict of Interest and Post-Employment Code for Public Office Holders. These consultation documents are the subject of review by Parliamentarians. In addition, on February 6, 2003, the President of the Treasury Board introduced legislation to modernize human resources management in the federal public service.
