No major legislation aimed at implementing the Convention has been enacted since the last meeting of the Committee.

United States is participating in an international group that is drafting legislation to be used in implementing the United Nations Anticorruption Convention. Considering the overlap between the two conventions, the models should prove useful to countries in the hemisphere, both on matters already covered by the Committee and those to be covered in the second round.

The United States is also participating in the Steering Committee for the Fourth Global Anticorruption Forum in Brazil next June and it is anticipated that appropriate attention will be given at the Forum to the Inter-American Convention and the Mechanism.
