Report on Compliance with Quota Payments

According to AG/RES. 1757 (XXX-O/00), and as amended by AG/RES.2157 (XXXV-O/05)

The status of member states with respect to payments of their assessment to the Regular Fund as of June 30th 2021 is as follows:
