HEMISPHERIC SEMINAR: CHALLENGES OF WOMEN IN PORTS IN THE XXI CENTURY

- 1. <u>Background</u>: The Tenth Executive Board Meeting of the Inter-American Committee on Ports (CECIP) (Buenos Aires, Argentina, March, 2009) adopted Resolution CIDI/CECIP/RES.11 (X-09) "Subcommittee on the Participation of Women in Port Affairs of the Hemisphere", which includes in the 2009 Work Plan the organization of a hemispheric seminar on a topic to be decided upon, and to be held in the Dominican Republic, country that is currently holding the chair of the previously mentioned Subcommittee. In this sense, the Dominican Port Authority (APORDOM) has proposed the organization of the following event on the third quarter of 2009.
- 2. Name: "Hemispheric Seminar: Challenges of Women in Ports in the XXI century".
- **3.** <u>Organizers</u>: The Dominican Port Authority (APORDOM) and the Inter-American Committee on Ports (CIP) of the Organization of American States (OAS).
- **4.** Place and date: Meliá Hotel, Avenida George Washington 365 P.O. Box 9326, Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic. Monday, August 17 to Friday, August 21, 2009.
- **5.** General objectives: (a) To promote the exchange of information on topics related to women in port in relation to the XXI century challenges. (b) Sector awareness about the important role of women in port development. (c) To integrate and share experiences from different perspectives towards the strengthening of the hemispheric maritime-port sector.
- **6.** <u>Participants:</u> Officials, executives, experts, specialists and guest from the public and private sectors of the Member States of the OAS, especially from the maritime-port, industry, commerce, academic areas as well as the general public with interest in the subject. The expected participation is of 100 people.
