Impact of Substance Abuse


- 1. Drug abuse is responsible for 25,000 deaths annually and 100 billion dollars in annual costs for their care in health in the USA.
- 2. THE consumption of alcohol in the USA is responsible for 100,000 deaths annually and costs \$ 185 trillion health care.
- 3. Patients with problems of alcohol consumption to spend 15% of the national health budget, of which 39% of the costs are for secondary morbidity and social effects.
- Recent studies report that approximately 40 million Americans consume alcohol in excess of what is considered as recommended





Impact of substance abuse

5.-The study of comorbidity in USA has found 29% to 37% prevalence of psychiatric patients with alcohol abuse.



 - Ability form management competent in information systems







