Background

- Rebirth House was founded by George Maximin "Tambi" in 1988 on June 27th, which is also Tambi's birthday.
- Was incorporated by Parliamentary Act No. 34 of 1991
- Was granted an annual subvention by the Ministry of Consumer Affairs and Social Services on March 11, 1993

Background

- Registered its office at 005F Charford Court, Charlotte Street, according to the Companies Ordinance on May 17, 1993
- Was accorded Charitable Institution status by the Ministry of Finance on January 13, 1994, reconfirmed January 20, 1995

To provide:


- A facility for the training of recovering addicts in various skills and disciplines
- A facility where recovering addicts assist in the rehabilitation of fellow addicts, including women
- Prevention services to youth and public promoting understanding of and sensitivity to the pain and suffering of drug addiction

Locations

Rebirth House has three resident centres:

- one at St. Ann's, which includes our halfway house for working members
- a second at Carenage, which houses our storeroom and garage and
- our third major centre at Chaguaramas sometimes called Phase Five.

Staff Profile



- We use the bio-psycho-social model.
- The spiritual aspect, which transcends all denominations to recognize a Higher Power, through which all is attained and which runs through all that is.

- We awake early and pray at 6:00 am
- Exercise and chores

 Individual and group counselling and guidance in personal and career development

- Occupational therapy, skills development, and therapeutic farming of agriculture, poultry and livestock
- Group prayer is a critical ingredient and takes place at meal times and also at 3:00 p.m. at each centre
- Twelve-step meetings complete our daily activity on most days, with social activities on other days

• Our centres accommodate 80 persons and we are generally filled to capacity

• We ask for and upkeep of only \$750 TT per month but sometimes even this subsidized amount remains unpaid
