I. State Level

State situational analysis to identify strengths and weaknesses.

Development of public policy.

Design of management models

Design of evaluation instruments, monitoring and control

Legal adaptation

II. Individual Level

Biopsychosocial needs identification and diagnosis from a systemic perspective:

Design of the implementation plan: physical and mental health plan design life

Skills development and income generation social skills
Inclusion education

Judicial follow-up and monitoring (previous hearings and meetings, application of incentives and sanctions).
