







## ALTERNATIVES TO INCARCERATION MISSION TO GUYANA

Georgetown, Guyana. February 25-26, 2019

As part of the INL funded project "Case management approaches to support health-justice collaboration in the implementation of alternatives to incarceration," ES/CICAD is providing institutional support to TASC (Treatment Alternatives for Safe Communities) to develop a universal treatment curriculum for alternatives to incarceration. The first stage includes field visits to two countries (Jamaica and Guyana) to produce assessments before incountry workshops for policymakers, while the second stage consists of the pilot trainings and awareness-raising meetings. This visit serves the dual purpose of raising awareness on alternatives to incarceration and the Drug Treatment Court model among key political and civil society stakeholders, and delivering the pilot training to policymakers and operators.
