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INFORMATION BULLETIN Regular Virtual Session 30th of June, 2020

The XLVIII Meeting of the Group of Experts for the Control of Money Laundering (GELAVEX) will take place virtually on June 30, 2020, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon; and from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. The coordination meeting of the Chair, the Vice-Chair, and the Coordinators of the Working Subgroups and the Technical Secretariat will be held virtually on June 29, 2020.

The objective of the Meeting is to present the progress made on the products being developed within the framework of the 2018-2019 Work Plan, and as outlined under the 2018-2020 Strategic Plan.

Links to access both meetings will be provided individually to each person who emails their completed registration form to DDOT@oas.org. The type of link sent will be determined by the profile of the participant.

1. PLATFORM AND DELEGATIONS:

The XLVIII Meeting of the Group of Experts for the Control of Money Laundering will be held on the **Kudo** Platform. Instructions on how to connect are attached to this Information Bulletin.

Each Member State and Permanent Observer delegation may designate up to 2 (two) Speaker delegates who will have access to the platform with the possibility of requesting to speak during the session, as well as to vote on behalf of their delegation. Speaking requests from delegates will be authorized if the delegation wishes to make comments, clarify doubts and / or present relevant







contributions after the presentation of the Sub-Groups. Also, each delegation may have **a maximum of 3 (three)** non-speaking delegates who can attend the meeting virtually but would not be able to request to speak.

In the event that any delegation requires an exception, they are asked to submit a request via email to pdot@oas.org, which will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis. The Technical Secretariat recommends that the delegations establish a parallel communication system between their primary (speaking) and alternate (non-speaking) delegates to coordinate the comments and contributions that non-speaking delegates may wish to make through their speaking delegates during the meeting. On page 3 of this document are some best practice recommendations for speaking and for the optimal use of time during this virtual meeting.

Finally, we ask the delegations that have not yet registered to kindly indicate which of their delegates will be speakers and which will be non-speakers, so that we can share with them the appropriate link to the platform. To the delegations that have already registered their delegates, we will confirm the roles of each one with their respective Permanent or Observer Missions.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE PLATFORM AND THE USE OF TIME

We recommend that delegates follow the guidelines below to optimize the use of time during the meeting:







 Access to the platform will be available one hour before the start of the meeting. To enter, we suggest the following username format:

COUNTRY (Name Surname - Agency) Example: BOLIVIA (Juan Perez - FIU)

We suggest abbreviating the agency name: Financial Intelligence Unit - FIU; Attorney General's Ministry - AGM; Department of Justice – DOJ; Asset Management Agency – AMA, etc.

- We respectfully suggest that delegations, when taking the floor, forego the customary remarks of thanks and greetings to better take advantage of the time of the meeting;
- Due to the time limitations of this meeting, in accordance with the rules defined by the Chair, delegations wishing to intervene after the presentations of the coordinators of the Sub-Groups are asked to keep their remarks to a maximum of 3 minutes per delegation, to allow all delegations the possibility of speaking within the allotted time.
- Delegations with 2 (two) registered speaking delegates are asked to coordinate when requesting the floor to allow time for other delegations to speak;
- The Department against Transnational Organized Crime kindly requests that delegations connect 30 minutes on before the start time of the Virtual Meeting on June 30th to resolve any technical issues and to ensure that the meeting starts on time.

We are excited to have you taking part of a meeting on KUDO. Please refer to the items below to help you prepare and make the most of the presentation.



A Good Headset

- Ideally, a USB Headset. (Professional-grade is highly recommended)
- Avoid using earbuds type unless you are following from your phone.
- Place the microphone close to your mouth but avoid breathing into it.



Internet Connectivity

- Use Google Chrome as your browser.
- Use a wired connection.
- · If wired connection is not available, use high-speed Wi-Fi instead.

(Ideally 20 and 5 Mbps, for download and upload respectively. 5Ghz / 802.11ac is highly recommended)

1 A Webcam

- An HD webcam is preferred to get a high quality video.
- Point the camera directly at yourself.
- When you seat in front of your computer, leave enough distance between you and the camera, so your face is entirely visible.



Professional Environment

- Choose a private and quiet room to speak from.
- Make sure the lighting in the room is adequate.
- Place yourself so that there is a blank or plain background.




From a computer





On **Google Chrome** go to the **provided link**. Fill out the form, click **Join Session**, and you're in!








From a smartphone
