

**PRESENTING THE 2021-2023 BIENNIAL REPORT OF CITEL'S MEMBER STATES ON
RESOLUTION AG/RES. 2935 (XLIX-O/19) HEMISPHERIC EFFORTS TO COMBAT THE USE
OF MOBILE TERMINAL DEVICES THAT HAVE BEEN STOLEN, LOST OR TAMPERED
WITH TO THE OAS GENERAL ASSEMBLY**

The 42 Meeting of Permanent Consultative Committee I: Telecommunications/Information and Communications Technologies (PCC.I),

DECIDES:

1. To adopt the questionnaire annexed hereto containing information on efforts by CITEL Member States to combat the use of mobile terminal devices that have been stolen, lost or tampered with, addressed in paragraph 6 of the operative part of Resolution AG/RES. 2935 (XLIX-O/19).
2. To set **31 August 2023** as the deadline for sending in answers to the questionnaire referenced in paragraph 1 hereof, which should be sent to Mr. Hugo Romero (hugo.romero@ccom.gov.co), Rapporteur on Compliance, Fraud Control and Illegal or Irregular Mobile Devices, with a copy to the CITEL Secretariat (citel@oas.org).
3. To urge all Member States to send in, by the aforementioned deadline, their answers to the questionnaire annexed hereto, considering the terms of reference given in Resolution AG/RES. 2935 (XLIX-O/19).
