While Belize did not enter any Reservation to the Treaty in accordance with Article XVI, the Central Authority requests that all documents submitted thereto pursuant to the present Convention, be in the English language or accompanied by a certified English translation.

Further, with respect to Articles III, IV, V and VI Belize understands that the consent requirements established therein are cumulative. Consequently, the transfer of a sentenced person under this Convention will require the concurrence of the Sentencing State, the Receiving State, and the prisoner.
