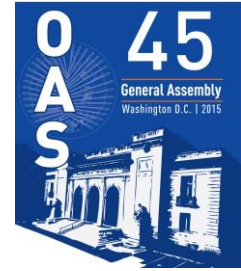

1. Venue of the General Assembly:

The forty-fifth regular session of the General Assembly of the Organization of American States will be held from June 15-16, 2015, in Washington, D.C. The sessions will be held in the Hall of the Americas in the OAS Main Building, located at the corner of 17th Street and Constitution, N.W., Washington, D.C., 20006, United States of America.

Late registration for official delegations and the **delivery of identification cards** will be done starting on June 12, 2015 in the TL-76 Room at the OAS General Secretariat Building, **1889 F Street, NW, Washington, DC 20006**: On Friday, June 12 from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.; on Saturday, June 13 from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00pm; on Sunday, June 14 from 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.; and June 15 and 16, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

For security reasons, I.D.s will be required for all General Assembly activities. The delegations and other participants are asked kindly to present a copy of their official credentials when registering.

7. Working languages and documents:

The General Assembly working meetings will be conducted in the official languages of the Organization: Spanish, English, French and Portuguese, for all of which simultaneous interpretation will be provided. Since greening measures will be in effect and **the printing of documents will be limited**, participants are requested to keep their documents during all meetings.
