1. Strengthening Democracy through Measures to Eradicate Poverty and Promote Integral Development;
2. Hemispheric Steps to enhance Cybersecurity and electronic privacy;
3. Execution of the Hemispheric Plan of Action against Transnational Organized Crime and Strengthening of Hemispheric Cooperation;
4. Election of General Officers for the 2015 Washington MOAS.

### **First Committee: Juridical and Political Affairs**

1. Official Public Defenders as a Guarantee of Access to Justice for Persons in Situations of Vulnerability;
2. Multilateral strategies to establish legally-binding Hemispheric mechanisms against all forms of racism and intolerance;
3. Enhancing the right to truth in regard to disappeared persons and assistance to members of their families;
4. Protection of Asylum Seekers and Refugees in the Americas;

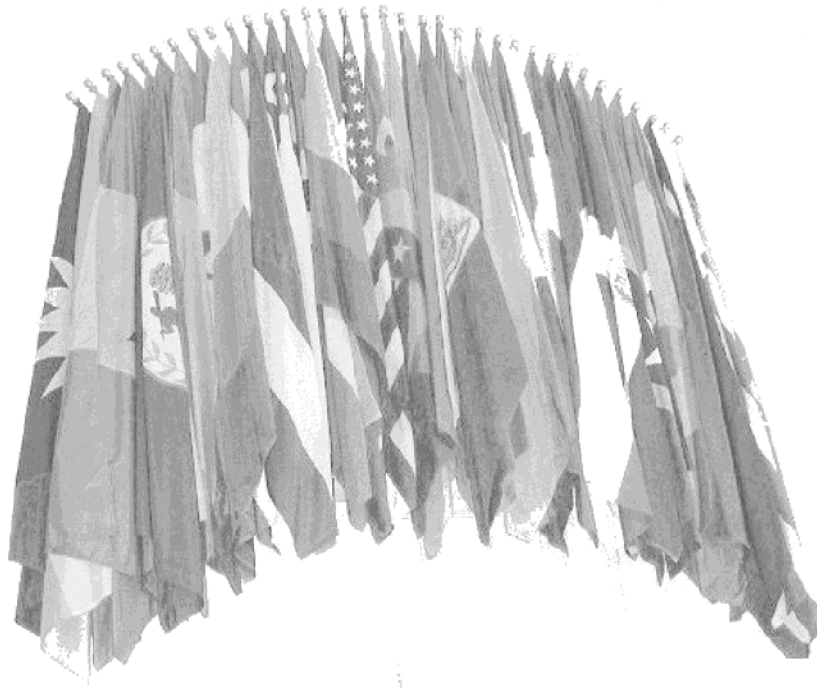
