CP/RES. 348 (475/81)

REQUEST BY THE GOVERNMENT OF MOROCCO TO ACCREDIT
A PERMANENT OBSERVER TO THE ORGANIZATION

- CONSIDERING:

That through resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71), the General Assembly established the status of Permanent Observer to the Organization of American States and entrusted the Permanent Council with the task of determining the criteria and timeliness to give effect to and implement this provision; and

That in accordance with resolution CP/RES. 52 (61/72), non-American states that participate in programs of the Organization may request Permanent Observer status to the OAS, in accordance with resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71); and

HAVING SEEN the request presented by the Government of Morocco that it be granted the aforementioned benefits (CP/doc.1175/81), and also the information provided by the General Secretariat, in which it states that that country has offered to participate in the programs of the Organization (CP/CG-1154/81 corr. 2, CP/CG-1165/81 and CP/CG-1178/81), and

TAKING INTO ACCOUNT that that country has expressed interest that the Permanent Observer appointed by it be accredited to the various organs, agencies, and entities of the Organization,

RESOLVES:

- l. To accede to the request of the Government of Morocco, under the terms of resolution AG/RES. 50 (I-0/71) of the General Assembly and resolution CP/RES. 52 (61/72) of this Council.
- 2. To state that the Government of Morocco may accredit Permanent Observers to the various organs, agencies, and entities of the Organization. The provisions of paragraph 7 of resolution CP/RES. 52 (61/72) will prevail in the case of accreditation to the Specialized Organizations.
- 3. To request the Secretary General to take the necessary steps to comply with this resolution.
