Each project aims to **benefit displaced persons** through:



The provision of humanitarian assistance.



Strengthening response capacity by modernizing processes and developing institutional capabilities.



Facilitating the issuance of documentation to enable access to basic state services.



Generating durable solutions to promote sustainable and safe integration into host communities, ensuring the enjoyment of their rights.



Providing comprehensive care, protection, and reinstatement of rights for returned children and adolescents, and their families.

To date **+24,000** benefited persons

48% men	34% women	17% children and adolescents

At the conclusion of the first portfolio, a total of **+100,000** persons across the region will be benefited.

The projects include a cross-cutting perspective on **rights and inclusion**.
