The Migration and Forced Displacement Section supports the efforts of OAS Member States in developing and implementing policies, programs, projects and initiatives on human mobility to promote the full enjoyment of the rights of migrants, refugees and displaced people in the region. Its objective is to strengthen cooperation between the countries of origin, transit, destination and return to contribute to the comprehensive management of migration, implement comprehensive responses to address the structural causes of migration, and address the risks and violations to which migrants, refugees and displaced people are exposed.

- Coordinates the implementation of mandates related to food security and multidimensional poverty in the region, in collaboration with other areas.

- Promotes the Rights of Afro-descendants: Technical Secretariat
 of the Inter-American Network of High Authorities on Policies for
 Afro-descendant Populations (RIAFRO) and monitoring the
 implementation of the Action Plan for the Decade of People of
 African Descent in the Americas (2016–2025).
- Promotes the Rights of Indigenous Peoples: Monitoring of the implementation of the American Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples and its Working Group.
- Promotes the rights of older persons: Monitoring the implementation of the Inter-American Convention on the Protection of the Human Rights of Older Persons.
- Promotes the fight against Racism and All Forms of Discrimination and Intolerance.


