Activities:	Provide online training, dynamic learning, remote training labs, mentoring and hands-on experiences to equip youth with the necessary skills and internationally recognized credentials to operate in the jobs of the future and transformative technologies.
Cost and Funding:	The Academy will build on existing resources and partner offerings from OAS Member States, academia, and the private sector.
