Substance Use Amongst Youth in Latin-America & The Caribbean

It is estimated that 37% to 68% of adolescents in Latin-America have used tobacco, 43% to 80% have used alcohol, and 4% to 23% have used marijuana.



In the Caribbean, 8.4% of men and 3.2% of women between 15-19 years of age are involved in alcohol use; and 2.5% of men and 1.8% of women in the same age group are involved in illegal drug use




GIVEN BY GABRIELA MAIA TO 12 YOUNG


