Sustainable Development USAID and Counternarcotics Efforts

- Since the mid-90s USAID has worked with the Peruvian government on Alternative Development (AD) through a specific office focused on AD.
- Alternative Development is a component of a more comprehensive strategy that also includes Interdiction and Eradication
- In 2004 USAID helped to create DEVIDA, the national agency responsible for coordinating all of Peru's counternarcotics efforts and implementing the National Anti-Drug Policy
- Current context: Illicit coca cultivation has increased from 40,000 Ha in 2015 to 95,000 Ha in 2022 (coca expanded to new areas: indigenous territories, natural protected areas, buffer zones, and forest concessions in the Amazon)


Sustainable Development Activities

Sustainable Development Strategic Outcomes

- Strengthened implementation of Peru's National Anti-Drug Policy (PNCD).
- Increased productivity and incomes, improved livelihoods, and improved access to markets and other essential services/goods for smallholder farmers/SMEs.
- Improved access to basic public services, as well as financial and digital services; improved capacity of local governments to deliver basic services.
- Reduced deforestation and carbon emissions from smallholder farmers and businesses; actions implemented by them to better adapt to climate change.



Sustainable Development Achievements

- USAID's support has been instrumental in Peru's coffee and cacao/chocolate boom over the past 15 years. Peru is now the world's leading producer of organic coffee and second leading producer of organic cacao.
- In the past five years, 87,200 smallholder farm families improved their living conditions. Their incomes increased by 97.5%; they accessed over \$92 million in financing; and they improved productivity and quality of licit crops.
- USAID-assisted farm families sold over \$145 million of cacao and coffee last year.
- Since 2018, USAID has facilitated the investment of over \$625 million in public funds to help local governments improve basic public services.
