
### **Capacity Building:**

- ☐ Goal: Build the capacity of youth to take action in drug use prevention and health promotion
- ☐ Global and regional (Barbados 2019 and Bahamas 2023) youth forums on drug use prevention
- ☐ National trainings (2023: Argentina, Bahamas, Peru, Brazil)
- ☐ 159 youth from 18 OAS member states

### Pilot Program for Preventing Drug Use & Supporting Mental Health (SADD Model)



- ☐ Partnership with SADD since 2021
- ☐ Participating countries: The Bahamas & Suriname
- □ Participation is currently open to all OAS English-speaking Member States, and, in the future, Latin America

## Youth Network: Engagement and Participation

◆ Provide an opportunity for young people to participate in drug demand reduction discussions and programming at the global and national levels

◆ Provide access to training and capacity building opportunities in Drug Demand Reduction

- **♦** Connect youth from different parts of the world to share experiences and discuss relevant issues in their communities
- ♦ Spark the interest of youth to become a drug demand reduction professional
